Student Development Programme:

1. Academic facilities:

Our College provides Tutorial assistance in academic skills development on a walk-in, scheduled or referral basis as well as workshops on a variety of topics. Study skills, such as notes taking, Test practice and awareness of time management are offered in each semester.

2. Placement Cell:

Our College organizes separate Placement Training Classes for all students regularly. In the academic year 2017 – 2018, Mega Job Mela and other campus interviews were conducted, 727 students were placed and recruited in various companies like TCS, WIPRO, Capgemini, IDBI, Aegis, Kotak Ltd., etc.

3. EDP Cell:

Our College has established an "Entrepreneurial Development Programme" cell to create awareness among our students and it motivates them to become successful Future Entrepreneurs by attending various Training Programmes.

4. ICWA & CA Awareness Programme:

This programme offers various opportunities and awareness camps especially for Commerce and Management students to pursue high level professional courses like CA/ICWA.

5. Orientation Programmes:

Our College is committed to set up equal educational opportunities and reinforces commitment among the students and the staff through a programme among the staff and the students of active affirmation of Diversity. Various activities like Guest Lectures, Seminars, Communicative and Spoken classes, Workshops, and so on are conducted department-wise regularly.

6. TNPSC/ Bank exam Coaching:

We provide TNPSC coaching and Bank exam coaching regularly having tieups with renowned coaching centers every week so that when they participate in competitive exams they can come out successfully with Government and banking jobs.

7. Certificate courses

8. Students Welfare Committee:

The welfare of the students has given paramount importance in our college. As such, a student welfare committee exists in each department to administer the crucial responsibility of ensuring the physical and mental well-being of the students.

LIBRARY AND LAB FACILITIES:-

Our college Library is well-equipped with 12,500 books and 40 journals. For the sake of improving the research activities, we have digitalized the library along with Inflibnet facilities.

We have well-equipped laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Botany, Zoology, Textile, and Fashion Design and Nutrition Dietetics courses. There are more than 150 computer Systems in the computer science Lab.

SEMINARS:-

We have been organizing seminars and symposia to enrich the academic knowledge of our students and to make them apply such knowledge regularly in dayto-day life. The Department of Physics organized an International Level seminar on Crystal growth and the Department of Chemistry organized a National Conference on Novel Advanced application in chemistry. The Department of Maths has organized an intercollegiate "Math Fest" and the Tamil department organized a national-level seminar on Archeology. All these events cater to the social and industrial needs of the present employment scenario of our society among our students every year.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES:-

We have celebrated International Women's Day, National Integration Day, Bharathiyar's Birthday, Sports Day, College Day, Teacher's Day, Founder's Day, Annual Day, and Pongal celebration in a grand manner and fine fashion.

HEALTH CAMP:-

Every year we organize a Health camp with the assistance of our nursing college to create awareness about health problems such as anemia, eye problems, and other hidden diseases. In addition every month we are busy organizing **Free Eye camp** to provide help to the rural people keeping collaboration with Aravind Eye Hospital, Coimbatore.

INDUSTRIAL VISITS:-

The main objective of Industrial visits is to give the students to get a first-hand experience with the industries and environmental conditions. The departments of BBA, Chemistry, Computer Science, Botany, Zoology, and Nutrition and Dietetics took their students on industrial visits to renowned industries at Hosur, Bangalore, Kodaikanal, Sirgazhi, and Krishnagiri respectively.

EDUCATIONAL TOUR AND FIELD VISITS:-

All the departments are organizing Educational tours for their respective students to various tourist spots. Field visits are also being organized to improve the subject knowledge of the students.

MOTIVATION PROGAMMES:-

We conduct motivational programs every year to motivate the students for excellent achievement in the academic area and other areas.
