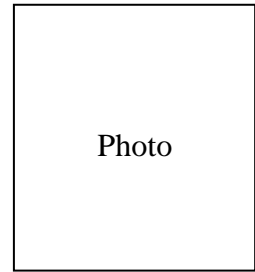

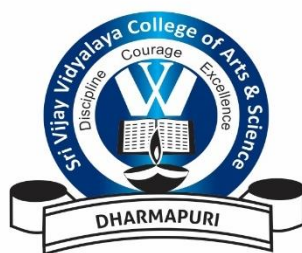

## **SRI VIJAY VIDYALAYA COLLEGE OF ARTS & SCIENCE (WOMEN)**

Sri Vijay Vidyalaya Educational Trust was founded in the year 1987 by Thiru DNC.Manivannan who is the Chairman. He is the Elder Son of Sri.D.N.Chinnasamy, who is an Educationist and Philanthropist par excellence and also the founder of Sri Vijay Vidyalaya Educational Institutions in the Town of Dharmapuri & Hosur.

Sri Vijay Vidyalaya College of Arts & Science was started with an affiliation from Periyar University, Salem in July 2009, with 250 students & 11 teachers in the campus of Gandhi Nagar School, Dharmapuri.

In the year 2010, this institution entered into their own campus. Currently it has many facilities such as well modern equipped laboratories and well maintained campus, quality programmes and library services. Our institutional reputation reflects the quality & dedication of its administration and faculties in their commitments to meet the needs of the communities and students it serves. At present the college offers 20 (UG) Courses, 10 (PG) Courses, 9 (M.Phil.) Programmes and 7 (Ph.D) Programmes.

### **Result:-**

So far the College has achieved excellent Academic progress in Periyar University Examinations. In May 2017, the overall pass percentage was 97% for U.G Courses and 90% for P.G Courses and M.Phil. Our college achievements have touched crescendo by the attainment of '4' Gold Medals (M.Sc.Chemistry, B.B.A., B.C.A., B.Sc. Botany), **40** Rank Holders in various UG Courses and **9** Rank Holders in various PG Courses and **6** Rank Holders in various M.Phil. Courses. In addition **283** students of various departments such as Mathematics (246), Chemistry (14), Physics (12), Statistics (5), B.B.A. (3), B. Com. (2) and Geography (1) have secured centum so far.

### **Academic Achievements:-**

In the very recent year 2017 National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) was fully satisfied with the facilities and services provided to the student's community and has authorized our college with the credit points of A. Prior to the above status, our college was recognized as 2(f) and 12(b) status under UGC, Act 1956. This enables the staff and research scholars to indulge themselves to take initiative in research work with the obtainment of stipend sponsored by the UGC, CSIR and other research promotion institutions. The College encourages our students to participate in various Inter Collegiate meet and Association Programmes. In such events students get lots of prizes and cash awards and bring laurels to our institution.

### **Alumni Association:-**

Alumni were properly registered on the 7<sup>th</sup> June 2017, under the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act 1975 by the college for the benefit of former students. Alumni create better relationship among the students and to remain as part of it.

### **Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC):-**

IQAC has also been established for realizing the goals of quality enhancement and sustenance. The main aim of the cell is to develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the academic excellence of institution. The President of the cell is Prof. Dr. S. Govindarajan, coordinator of the cell is Dr. P. Velusamy, Management Representative is Mr. M. Deepak, (Director), Other university Representative are Dr. C. Selvaraj, Professor and Head, Department of Mathematics, Periyar University, Dr. A. Muthusamy, Professor, Department of Mathematics, Periyar University and Dr. R. Raja, Assistant Professor and Head i/c, Ramanujan Centre for Higher Mathematics, Alagappa University. IQAC conducts its periodical meeting once in every three month of a year.

### **Sports Achievements:-**

Our institution focuses not only on Academic development activities but also on development of sports activities too. In December 2012. Our college got 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> prizes of Gold and bronze medals in the inter Collegiate Takewanda Competition of Periyar University under All India University Tournament at Chandigarh. Many

achievements were made in the sports. In 4<sup>th</sup> August 2017 third position was placed by our students in the Table Tennis University level held at K.S.R. College of Arts and Science, Tiruchengode. In 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> August 2017 similar participation was made by our students in the Volley Ball University level held at P.S.A. College of Arts and Science, Dharmapuri.

### **LIBRARY:**

- The library is kept open from 9.30 AM to 4.00 PM on all working days without any break.
- Strict silence should be observed in the library.
- Personal belongings such as bags, Tiffin boxes, notes etc should be left at the entrance of the library.

- Digital Electronic Library adjoined in the library hall with the facilities of 30 systems providing simple and smooth access to the resources. It provides free access to the various paid journals and websites.
- Members of teaching faculty can borrow up to 7 books at a time.
- Bar code is embedded in the students' identity card. Students can obtain books by showing their id card. 2 Books, 3 Books and 5 Books will be issued to the UG, PG and M.Phil. Students respectively. The same will be the procedure for the staff members to obtain books.
- Lending Period
  - For Staff - 30 days
  - For Students:UG-10 days, PG- 15 days& M. Phil – 20 days
- Books may be renewed for a further period if there is no demand for them from other students.
- Reference Books such as dictionary, encyclopedia and books labelled as books for reference, will not be lent.
- Students and Staff should not damage, write or make any mark on any books or periodicals belonging to the library.
- If a book is lost or missed, the borrower shall either pay 2 times of its cost or replace it with a new copy immediately.
- Students and Staff must examine the books on receiving it and report to the librarian about any damage found therein. Otherwise, the borrower will be responsible for the damage.
- Sub-lending of books is also forbidden.
- Students & Staff should return all books borrowed from the library one week before the last working day of the academic year.
- Theft, vandalism and destruction of library books, journals and related materials are also considered as serious offences and those who cause such offences will be dealt with seriously.
- Students and Staff should take care of their purses, key bunches, diaries, notebooks etc. while they are in the library. The library is not responsible for any claim of loss or damage to such articles.

**Medium of Instruction:**

The medium of instruction is English.

**Admission Procedure:**

The prospectus and application form will be issued during the 1<sup>st</sup> week of May of every Academic Year.

**Registration:**

Filled in application forms for admission should reach the Principal with in three days from the date of issue.

Students seeking admission should enclose the following Original certificates and five Photostat copies of each certificate.

1. 10<sup>th</sup> Mark sheet.
2. +2 Mark sheet.
3. Transfer Certificate.
4. Community Certificate.
5. Four passport size photos & two stamp size photos.

**College fee:**

The academic year is divided into two semesters as Odd semester (June, July, August, September, October and November) & Even semester (December, January, February, March, April and May)

Fees will be collected in the month of June & December of every year. Fees once paid will not be refunded. Any student who leaves in the middle of the course should pay the fees for the whole course.

Fees once paid are neither refundable nor transferable under any circumstances. Withdrawal of the certificate is permitted on receipt of a request in writing from the parent clearing all fee arrears. It will be issued within 7 days after all dues are cleared.

**Working days:**

The college will work from Monday to Saturday.

Class hours: 9.30a.m to 4.00.p.m

**Uniform code:**

Students should wear uniform saree for all working days.

**Punctuality:**

Students should be punctual. Late comers will be dealt with severe action.

### **Attendance:**

80% attendance during each semester is a prerequisite for attending the semester examinations. The college has the right to withhold the students in case the minimum requirement is not fulfilled.

### **Absenteeism:**

Students may be absent from college only for essential and important reasons, such as illness or an emergency in the family. Parents must co-operate with the management in following this.

Leave letters should be duly signed by the parents. Absence for more than 3 days require a medical certificate.

In the event of planned absence, parents are requested to seek prior permission of the Principal.

### **Tutorial system:**

All staff members will take care of the academic progress of each student.

### **Parents:**

Changes in the address of parents must be intimated in writing. Parents are welcome to visit the college during working hours and give suggestions for the all-round development of the students and college as well.

Parents involvement and commitment is an important factor in enhancing the learning process. They are encouraged to meet the HODs after the completion of each Internal Examination.

The college is not responsible if they fail to see the progress card of the respective student.
