First of all, I would like to present our **Academic Excellence**

In the academic year **2021-22 and 2022-2023**, among the **Periyar University Examination results**, our college obtained remarkable academic progress.

2021-22

- **UG** - a total of 979 students appeared and 976 students passed with an overall pass percentage of 99.7%
- **PG** - a total of 174 students appeared and 169 students passed with an overall pass percentage of 97.10%

Among the results, our Students topped the **Periyar University ranking list** and secured **13 University Gold medals and 134 University Ranks**.

2022-23

- **UG** - a total of 636 students appeared and 627 students passed with an overall pass percentage of 98.4 %
- **PG** - a total of 169 students appeared and 164 students passed with an overall pass percentage of 97 %

1. Our college management supports women's education and to take the college motto to the next level, it grants **DNC SCHOLARSHIP and Free Education**
