Now I am extremely happy to submit this report of activities of the College for the year 2016-2017. The Strength of the College has increased from **250** Students in the academic Year 2009 -10 to **3800** in the academic year 2016 -2017. The college has expanded its wings in all disciplines and offices. **20** UG Courses, **10** PG Courses and **9** M.Phil Courses have been procured. To add more feathers to its cap, the College is equipped with research facilities in the Departments of Chemistry, Commerce, Computer Science, Physics and Tamil for Ph.D. Programs

## **RESULT :-**

Our College has achieved excellent Academic progress in Periyar University Examinations so far. In May 2017, the overall pass percentage was 97% for U.G Courses and 90% for P.G Courses and M.Phil. Our College achievements have touched crescendo by the attainment of '4' Gold Medals (M.Sc. Chemistry, B.B.A., B.C.A., B.Sc. Botany ), 40 Rank Holders in various UG Courses and 9 Ranks Holders in various PG Courses and 6 Rank Holders in various M.Phil Courses. In addition 302 students of various departments, such as Mathematics (246), Chemistry (14), Physics (12), English (19), Statistics (5), B.B.A. (3), B.Com. (2) and Geography (1) have, secured centum so far.

### **1. Academic facilities:**

Our College provides Tutorial assistance in academic skills development on a walk-in, scheduled or referral basis as well as workshops on a variety of topics. Study skills, such as notes taking, Test practice and awareness of time management are offered in each semester.

### **2. Placement Cell:**

Our College organizes separate Placement Training Classes for all students regularly. In the academic year 2017 – 2018, Mega Job Mela and other campus interviews were conducted, 727 students were placed and recruited in various companies like TCS, WIPRO, IDBI, Aegis, Kotak Ltd., etc.

Various activities like Guest Lectures, Seminars, Communicative and Spoken classes, Workshops and so on are conducted department wise regularly.

We provide TNPSC coaching and Bank exam coaching regularly having tie-up with renowned coaching center every week so that when they participate in competitive exams they can come out successfully with Government and banking jobs.

#### **8. Students Welfare Committee:**

#### **LIBRARY AND LAB FACILITIES:-**

Our college Library is well equipped with 10,000 books and 40 journals. For the sake of improving the research activities we have digitalized the library along with Inlibnet facilities.

We have got well equipped laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology and the Computer Science courses. There are more than 150 computer Systems in the computer science Lab.

### **SEMINARS:-**

We have been organizing seminars and symposia to enrich the academic knowledge of our students and to make them apply such knowledge regularly in day today life. Department of Physics organized an international level seminar on Crystal growth and Department of Chemistry organized a National Conference on Novel Advanced application in chemistry. Department of Maths has organized an intercollegiate “Math Fest” and Tamil department organized a national level seminar on Archeology. All these events cater to the social and industry needs of the present employment scenario of our society among our students every year.

### **CULTURAL ACTIVITES:-**

We have Celebrated International women’s day, National Integration day, Bharathiyar’s Birthday, Sports day, College day, Teacher’s day and Pongal celebration in a grand manner and fine fashion.

### **HEALTH CAMP:-**

Every year we are organizing Health camp with the assistance of our nursing college to create awareness about health problems such as anemia, eye problems and other hidden diseases. In addition every month we are busy organizing **Free Eye camp** to provide help to the rural people keeping collaboration with Aravind Eye Hospital, Coimbatore.

### **INDUSTRIAL VISITS :-**

The main objective of Industrial visits to make the students to get the first hand experience with the industries and environmental conditions. The departments of BBA, chemistry, Computer Science, Botany, Zoology and Nutrition and Dietetics took their students to industrial visits to renowned industries at Hosur, Bangalore, Kodaikanal, Sirgazhi and Krishnagiri respectively.
